Become a Community Redistribution Partner.

We partner with community-based Not for Profits who can receive large quantities of goods into their warehouses and distribute them to other Not for Profits and/or schools locally. We call them Community Redistribution Partners (CRPs). CRPs become the local hero in their region.

CRP vs standard Good360 membership.

The main difference between a standard Good360 member and a CRP is in how brand-new goods can be distributed. A CRP can distribute to individuals as well as other Not for Profit organisations and/or eligible schools. A standard Good360 member must only give to Australians in need and must not redistribute to other Not for Profits.

How do they work?

Our CRP members:

1. Want to expand the good work they are already doing by distributing increased product donations, becoming a Good360 regional hub for their community.
2. Already work with a network of vetted and qualified Not for Profit organisations and want lift-up for their local communities with the spare goods of businesses.
3. Operate a warehouse and have the ability to receive and distribute truckload-sized donations.
4. Know where their product donations go. They have an established vetting process for the Not for Profits and/or schools they support and a product distribution tracking method.

Distribution	Good360 will advise if it has any NFP contacts in the CRP's local area that could benefit from their services.	Only redistribute goods to Good360 members and ACNC registered Not for Profits and/or eligible schools (unless otherwise approved by Good360).
		Educate and train your recipient NFPs on how Good360 products can be used (e.g. must not be sold to fundraise and must be passed onto Australians in need for free).
		Use Good360's name and logo to promote your status as a Good360 CRP.
Operation	Good360 will provide logo, style guide and work with CRP to promote services in your region.	Be inclusive, fair and equitable in distributing products to your recipient NFPs.
	Good360 account manager will customise orders suitable for your communities' needs.	Provide cost-efficient, quality services to NFPs consistent with Good360's standards.
	Good360 will provide BULK discount price of 50% off most standard fees.	If you choose to, you may charge your recipient NFPs a nominal administrative fee to help cover your operating costs (optional). NB: Fees must never be charged to individual recipients.
	Good360 account manager will provide you with early access VIP offers, try to source your product needs where possible and help create special campaigns suitable for your organisation to ensure the spare goods of businesses are lifting up people in the community you are helping.	Keep donated product secure in a business location, e.g. a commercial warehouse.
		Track all distribution of Good360 product to recipient NFPs and submit reports on a quarterly basis to the Good360 team.
		Collect impact stories from your recipient NFPs and share these with Good360.
Promotion	Good360 will promote and share your impact stories to donors and on our website, social media feed and promotions where the opportunity is available.	Serve and engage your NFPs by communicating and promoting your offerings.
	Good360 will provide tools and resources to assist you in promoting your CRP status to your communities.	Protect the integrity of Good360 donations by implementing regular compliance measures, e.g. monitoring the quantities requested from your recipients to ensure they are reasonable for the size of the NFPs, planning periodic compliance spot checks and immediately contacting Good360 if you believe there is a security issue or products have been misused.
